27.2	Previous Topics & Approval of August 11, 2022 Meeting Minutes: A motion to approve the 8/11/2022 meeting minutes as submitted made by M. Massa and seconded by E. Colbert. Roll Call Vote: B. 27.3	Final GMP Review & Vote: C. Dell Angelo shares the final GMP was received on Friday 8/19 and Consigli has been working on the bid package up until 8/18. The final bid package is \$7,892,762.00. T. McCabe states that the budget is in a better place than two weeks ago and explains the largest concern last time was Drywall. Since then, Consigli received two additional drywall numbers and were able to bring that number closer to budget. Waterproofing, Landscaping, Door frames and hardware were all brought down as well. This allowed Consigli to get to the best price. Discussion: P. McGinn asks about the variance change in the bid package from \$2.1 million to now \$3.4 million and what contributed to that. T. McCabe responds that a couple of trades were higher than the estimate. Finish carpentry was a few hundred thousand over the budget. Metal panels was another large component that came a couple hundred thousand over budget. All trade subcontractors came in a little high between 7%-12%. Those trade contractors were mainly finish subcontractors such as tile, acoustical ceilings, resilient flooring, and painting. A lot of this was driven by the market, type of job, and competition. M\tambda. McCabe mentions Consigli only got two to three bidders in some trades. M. Burton responds saying the labor market is scarce right now along with the timing of the bid package being in August, it made this a tough competitive time in general. Two weeks ago, the budget was \$4.8 million over budget and that's why we took two more weeks to try to get that number down. J. Gonzalez asks if the change of the cost in the school results in more money paid by taxpayers. M. Burton responds saying the maximum grant amount for the project is \$17.628 million. That is the maximum the MSBA will contribute to the project. The \$3.45 million we are over budget whas hall contribute to the project. The \$3.45 million we are over budget sheet was sent to the MSBA. M. Burton plans to have a discussion with the MSBA to discuss how that is going to be i	Record

- B. Dunne states the MSBA has been very understanding of this due to market scarcity and they have been working with district on the financing. There may be ways as we go through the project to offset costs and not have a major impact. The mayor has looked at it and felt an additional bond would be the way to finance this project. An additional bond would be needed which will ultimately affect taxpayers.
- ▶ P. McGinn asks about MSBA flexibility in terms of reimbursement. M. Burton responds saying cities and towns have tried using other funds to compensate for the budget. Originally, the MSBA's stance was any federal money would be considered a third party and therefore would be a dollar-for-dollar reduction for the grant amount. Because of the outreach from mayors and town administrators, the MSBA has relaxed their stance on this issue. They indicated at their last board meeting that they will not reduce grants should a district choose to use them.
